36 holes Stableford runners-up - Men 3 divisions & Ladies 3 divisions

Each day:

18 holes Stroke Gross winner - Men A Grade (0-14 handicap)
18 holes Stroke Nett winner - Men A Grade (0-14 handicap)
18 holes Stableford winners - Men 3 divisions & Ladies 3 divisions
18 holes Stableford runners-up - Men 3 divisions & Ladies 3 divisions
Plus an overall consolation ball run-down as well as pin & approach shots.

The entry fee is **\$36.00 per player for the 2 day event (\$18 per single day) Fee also includes Pro Pin Shots.**

Hit-off times are **6.30 am to 8.15 am and 10.30 am to 12.30 pm** daily.

All players should report to the Starter in the Pro Shop at least 20 minutes prior to their hit-off time.

Competition Rules

Note. This event is being played under the auspices of the Queensland Veteran Golf Union.

Each competitor must be a financial member of a Veterans' Association or group and hold a current AGU or WGA handicap. The B.V.G.A. committee reserves the right to alter or vary the programme, divisional handicaps, or any event, if the number of competitors is deemed insufficient for a competition.

The rules of golf in force at the time and the local rules of Bargara Golf Club shall be the rules of the day. Should there be a dispute or doubt on a rule, a second ball should be played for that hole and a ruling sought later.

• **The competition will be divided into four handicap divisions for men and three for ladies. Men (division one) will play a stroke event, the remaining 3 divisions will be a stableford as will the 3 divisions for ladies.**

Only one overall or division trophy can be won each day (pinshots and approaches are excepted). Should scores be tied, the result will be decided by count-back.

Trophy presentations will be conducted daily.

Should play be stopped for any reason by the committee, the completion of nine holes by ALL competitors (excluding retirees) is the criteria. If the criteria is met, for the first and second daily competitions, only the first nine holes are counted. If not, the trophies are allocated by a draw. For the 36 holes overall competition, if the second day is not completed, then the winners of the first day shall be deemed the overall winners.

Golf Link cards are necessary to register for play and are to be presented to the Starter on check-in. If not held, then a Handicap Card should be available for perusal.

BBQ and Breakfast will be available at reasonable prices at the area next to the Pro Shop from 6.30am to 3pm daily.

The Bistro is open 7 days a week for lunch and dinner at the Clubhouse.
